Feline Behaviour Counselling

Do you need help with your cat's problem behaviour? The range of behavioural problems exhibited in cats is varied.

They include:

- Spraying
- Toileting problems
- Aggression to people
- Aggression in multi-cat households
- Nervousness
- Scratching carpets or furniture

If your cat is displaying any of the above or any other behaviour problem that is of concern to you, then help is available.

BEHAVIOUR CONSULTATIONS

Behaviour consultations are only available on veterinary referral. If you think your cat has a behaviour problem, it is important that you consult your vet first. If no medical problem is diagnosed you can ask to be referred to CAT-astrophes. Ask your vet to fill out the referral form overleaf, and then contact Kim to arrange an appointment.

Consultations are held at the owner's home. The consultation will normally last about 2 hours, during which time a detailed case history of the pet is taken and the problem behaviour assessed. It is preferable for all family members to be present.

At the end of the consultation, a diagnosis is made, the motivation for the behaviour explained, and outline advice given to the owners. Written notes, handouts and other information relevant to your pet's problem will be given at the time of the appointment.

A Comprehensive Behaviour Modification Plan is subsequently sent to the owner, normally within 7 days. The referring Veterinary Surgeon will also receive a copy of the consultation report.

Please Note: The behaviour modification plan advised may produce results very quickly, but often it will take time, effort and commitment by all of the family to produce the improved behaviour.
